




FY21 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) student enrollment decreased by ~23 FTE.






Total Receipts for FY21 were \$49,451 higher than projected for the year.






Total receipts averaged \$253,570 per month.




78% of Revenues for FY21 were derived from State Foundation payments.





FY21 total disbursements were \$393,225 lower than projected year-to-date.




Total disbursements have averaged \$270,231 per month.
